

ORDINANCE NO. 1090

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, WASHINGTON, RELATING TO AND PROVIDING FOR THE VACATING OF A PORTION OF A STREET LOCATED IN THE CITY OF AUBURN.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Auburn has passed and adopted a written Resolution resolving that a public hearing should be had upon the petition of the owners of property abutting the portion of the street to be vacated, for the purpose of hearing whether or not a portion of a street in the City of Auburn should be vacated, said portion of the street being vacated being described as follows:

The South 10 feet of Third Street N.E. between L Street N.E. and M Street N.E. situate in the City of Auburn, County of King, which abut the North line of Lots one (1), two (2), three (3) and four (4), Block five (5), David A. Botting second addition to Auburn, County of King, SUBJECT TO: easement retained by the City of Auburn for utility purposes.

WHEREAS said petitioners have filed a written petition with the City of Auburn to vacate the above described property upon which the petitioners own all abutting property, and

WHEREAS Notice of Public Hearing to vacate said portion of said street was given by the City Clerk of the City of Auburn posting three (3) copies of said notice in three (3) public places in the City of Auburn, and a copy of said notice on the portion of said street to be vacated, which posting was made on the 14th day of July, 1954, giving notice that the hearing on said petition was to be held on the 3rd day of August, 1954, at 8:00 P.M. in the City Hall of the City of Auburn, and

WHEREAS said public hearing was duly called and had on the 3rd day of August, 1954 at 8:00 P.M. at the City Hall of the City of Auburn:

NOW THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF AUBURN, WASHINGTON AS FOLLOWS:

Section 1. That a portion of a street in the City of Auburn described as follows:

The South 10 feet of Third Street N.E. lying between L Street N.E. and M Street N.E. situate in the City of Auburn, County of King, which abut the North line of Lot one (1), Lot two (2), Lot three (3) and Lot four (4), Block five (5), David A. Botting second addition to Auburn, County of King, SUBJECT TO: easement retained by the City of Auburn for utility purposes,

be and the same is hereby vacated and the vacating thereof is subject to the reservation of an easement over, across and under said vacated portion by the City of Auburn for the use of utility lines and public service utilities, and the property lying in said portion of said street shall be returned and belong to the abutting property owners on said portion of said street.

Section 2. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force five days from and after its passage and publication.
